Lydale Weaver, Allendale Township Human Resource Specialist, introduced a HR System within the existing BS&A program. The initial start up fee would be \$18,284.00 with an annual cost of \$6,165.00. The annual cost is \$1,335.00 less than the annual fees from the current HR program (Bamboo). He indicated the BS&A HR program would better suit the needs of the township. Mr. Weaver answered various questions from the board.

Chad Doornbos, Public Utilities Supervisor, outlined some proposed changes made in the Water System Ordinance Amendment, Sewer System Ordinance Amendment, Construction Standards Update, Copper Lines Enforcement Policy, and Utility Rates. Mr. Doornbos addressed several questions and concerns from board members.

2020-7 Water System Ordinance Amendment was introduced for first reading. 2020-8 Sewer System Ordinance Amendment was introduced for first reading.
