## **Rental Occupancy Regulations for Allendale Township:**

First, rental occupancy is not determined by the number of bedrooms contrary to popular belief. It is determined by what zoning district the property is in (R-1, R-2, R-3, and R-4). Group housing such as an off-campus apartment complex, is usually zoned in the R-3 or R-4 category and are allowed more renters than those zoned in an R-1 or R-2 zoning district. These districts are usually single homes and duplexes and allow only up to 2 unrelated persons or a family all related by blood, marriage, adoption, or guardianship.

In a nutshell, the way the house, duplex, apt. is zoned by the township determines the occupancy. Houses and duplexes will mostly be zoned as R-1, and R-2 which means occupancy will be no more than 2 unrelated persons, an owner plus 2 unrelated persons, a family all related by blood, marriage, adoption or guardianship, or a family plus one other non-related person. The bigger complexes are in an R-3- or R-4 zoning district which allows for 3-4 unrelated per unit.
